CCIB – CÁMARA DE COMERCIO ITALIANA BARCELONA, as Partner of the project “CROSS-BORDER CHAMBERS' NEW SERVICES as driver FOR SUSTAINABLE FAIR TRADE OF TEXTILE INDUSTRY ACROSS MEDITERRANEAN” (MEDinCHAMBERS), A_G_4.1_0342, funded under the Interreg NEXT MED 2021–2027 transnational cooperation programme, is seeking a TRAINING EXPERT FOR CAPACITY BUILDING (budget code: WP4.ES.PP2.42001) to support CCIB in the activities of WP4 - MEDinCHAMBERS support services.

The MEDinCHAMBERS project aims to strengthen cross-border governance in the textile value chains of Italy, Spain, Tunisia, Egypt and Turkey. Partner institutions operate with non-integrated structures, procedures and tools, making governance action necessary to create a durable network of knowledge and relations among EU and MPC Chambers of Commerce. The objective is to develop a shared knowledge framework (hubs & detectors) on rules, risks, resources and needs of the textile sector, and to create a MEDinCHAMBERS cross-border operational team composed of bilateral Mediterranean Chambers of Commerce.

CCIB is partner of this international partnership composed of: Consorzio Universitario di Economia Industriale e Manageriale (CUEIM), Italy; Centre for Research and Technology Hellas (CERTH), Greece; Chambre Tuniso-Italienne de Commerce et d'Industrie (CTICI), Tunisia; Confederation of Egyptian European Business Associations (CEEBA), Egypt; Italian Chamber of Commerce and Industry for Turkey – Izmir (CCI-Izmir), Turkey; and RIBERA Consortium (CRIB), Spain.

DUTIES

The selected expert shall support CCIB as **TRAINING EXPERT FOR CAPACITY BUILDING** within WP4 activities. The expert is responsible for designing and delivering training and capacity building activities targeting Chambers of Commerce and Industry (CCIs), sectoral stakeholders, and project partners, ensuring methodological quality and adaptation to diverse cross-cultural audiences.

1. Design and delivery of training campaigns

- Design and deliver training campaigns for CCIs and sectoral associations in line with the project's capacity building objectives.
- Develop structured training modules and methodological frameworks adapted to diverse audiences, including CCIs, sectoral associations, and business operators.
- Ensure coherence between training content and the strategic objectives of WP4.

2. Support to the Living Lab in Tunis

- Support the Living Lab in Tunis as a capacity building facilitator.
- Apply living lab methodologies and co-creation approaches to facilitate cross-cultural and multi-stakeholder learning environments.
- Contribute to co-creation sessions of the Digital Detector within the Living Lab framework.

3. Design and delivery of the bootcamp in Spain

- Design and deliver training modules for the one-week bootcamp to be held in Spain.
- Ensure the bootcamp programme is tailored to the needs of CCIs, sectoral associations, and project partners.

4. Training support for matchmaking and business visits

- Provide training and methodological support for matchmaking business visits in Italy and Egypt.
- Support capacity building activities for the Regional Quadruple Helix (QH) Hub in Spain.

5. Dissemination and facilitation activities

- Assist with technical dissemination and facilitation activities during Info Days, including parallel thematic sessions.
- Support the preparation of training-related documentation and reporting contributions within WP4.

REQUIREMENTS

Professional background in education, adult learning, international cooperation, textile or related disciplines, or fields connected to capacity building and training design.

Proven experience in designing and delivering training programmes, workshops, or bootcamps, preferably in the context of EU-funded projects or international cooperation initiatives.

Experience in facilitation of multi-stakeholder and cross-cultural learning environments, including living lab methodologies and co-creation approaches.

Familiarity with the textile, fashion, or TCLF sector is considered a strong asset.

Good knowledge of Spanish and English; knowledge of French, Italian, or Arabic is considered an advantage given the transnational nature of the project.

Ability to design structured training modules and methodological frameworks adapted to diverse audiences, including CCIs, sectoral associations, and business operators.

Ability to work in multidisciplinary and multicultural teams with autonomy, methodological rigor, and attention to detail.

TYPE, DURATION AND REMUNERATION

The assignment will be formalized through a professional services contract, starting from the date of signature and lasting until the end of the project 23/09/27. The gross remuneration, inclusive of VAT, amounts to a total of **€13.000,00**. The gross remuneration includes the travel and subsistence costs incurred for the efficient accomplishment of the allocated tasks.
