CCIB – CÁMARA DE COMERCIO ITALIANA BARCELONA, as Partner of the project “CROSS-BORDER CHAMBERS' NEW SERVICES as driver FOR SUSTAINABLE FAIR TRADE OF TEXTILE INDUSTRY ACROSS MEDITERRANEAN” (MEDinCHAMBERS), A_G_4.1_0342, funded under the Interreg NEXT MED 2021–2027 transnational cooperation programme, is seeking a TCLF Local Expert to support CCIB in the technical part of WP3 “Analysis of needs and Impacts” of the project.

The MEDinCHAMBERS project aims to strengthen cross-border governance in the textile value chains of Italy, Spain, Tunisia, Egypt and Turkey. Partner institutions operate with non-integrated structures, procedures and tools, making governance action necessary to create a durable network of knowledge and relations among EU and MPC Chambers of Commerce. The objective is to develop a shared knowledge framework (hubs & detectors) on rules, risks, resources and needs of the textile sector, and to create a MEDinCHAMBERS cross-border operational team composed of bilateral Mediterranean Chambers of Commerce.

CCIB is partner of this international partnership composed of: Consorzio Universitario di Economia Industriale e Manageriale (CUEIM), Italy; Centre for Research and Technology Hellas (CERTH), Greece; Chambre Tuniso-Italienne de Commerce et d'Industrie (CTICI), Tunisia; Confederation of Egyptian European Business Associations (CEEBA), Egypt; Italian Chamber of Commerce and Industry for Turkey – Izmir (CCI-Izmir), Turkey; and RIBERA Consortium (CRIB), Spain.

DUTIES

The selected expert shall support CCIB as **Green TCLF local expert**. The expert provides technical consultancy on green transition in the textile and fashion sector, contributing to analysis, co-design, and development of tools and services for Chambers of Commerce and sectoral stakeholders, in compliance with the approved Application Form and Interreg NEXT MED requirements.

1. Technical consultancy on green transition and regulatory compliance

- Provide technical consultancy on green packaging, EU trade requirements, and sustainable production standards applicable to the TCLF sector.
- Support the comparison and mapping of national regulations on sustainability and packaging across partner countries (Spain, Italy, Tunisia, Egypt, Turkey).
- Contribute to the identification of EU and national targeted policies for greener textile production.

2. Gap analysis and service design

- Support the compilation of innovation-driven tools and models for new CCI-tailored services.
- Conduct gap analyses on existing CCI services in relation to green transition needs of the TCLF sector.
- Contribute to the identification of priorities for service design and the definition of end-user requirements.



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3. Facilitation of multi-stakeholder working groups

- Facilitate 4-Helix stakeholder focus groups involving public, private, academic, and civil society actors.
- Support co-design processes with local and transnational partners to ensure alignment with sectoral needs.
- Contribute to the joint design of Local Pilot Knowledge Hubs in Barcelona/Spain.

4. Contribution to the MEDinCHAMBERS Detector

- Contribute to the jointly designed MEDinCHAMBERS Detector developed by the Local Pilot Knowledge Hubs.
- Support the integration of technical findings into shared knowledge frameworks and operational tools.

REQUIREMENTS

Degree in environmental sciences, textile engineering, circular economy, European policies, or fields related to sustainability and the textile and fashion industry.

Proven technical experience in the textile, clothing, leather, or footwear (TCLF) sector, with a particular focus on green transition, sustainable packaging, and EU regulatory compliance. Previous experience in European or international cooperation projects is considered an asset.

Strong understanding of EU trade requirements, national regulations on sustainability and packaging, and European and national policies for greener textile production.

Ability to conduct gap analyses, map policies and regulations, and support the design of innovative services tailored to Chambers of Commerce.

Experience in facilitating multi-stakeholder working groups and collaborating with public, private, academic, and civil society actors within a 4-Helix model.

Good command of Spanish and English; knowledge of French, Italian, or Arabic is considered an advantage given the transnational nature of the project.

Ability to work in multidisciplinary and multicultural teams with autonomy, methodological rigor, and attention to detail.

TYPE, DURATION AND REMUNERATION

The assignment will be formalized through a professional services contract, starting from the date of signature and lasting until the end of the project 23/09/27. The gross remuneration, inclusive of VAT, amounts to a total of **€16,000,00**. The gross remuneration includes the travel and subsistence costs incurred for the efficient accomplishment of the allocated tasks.
